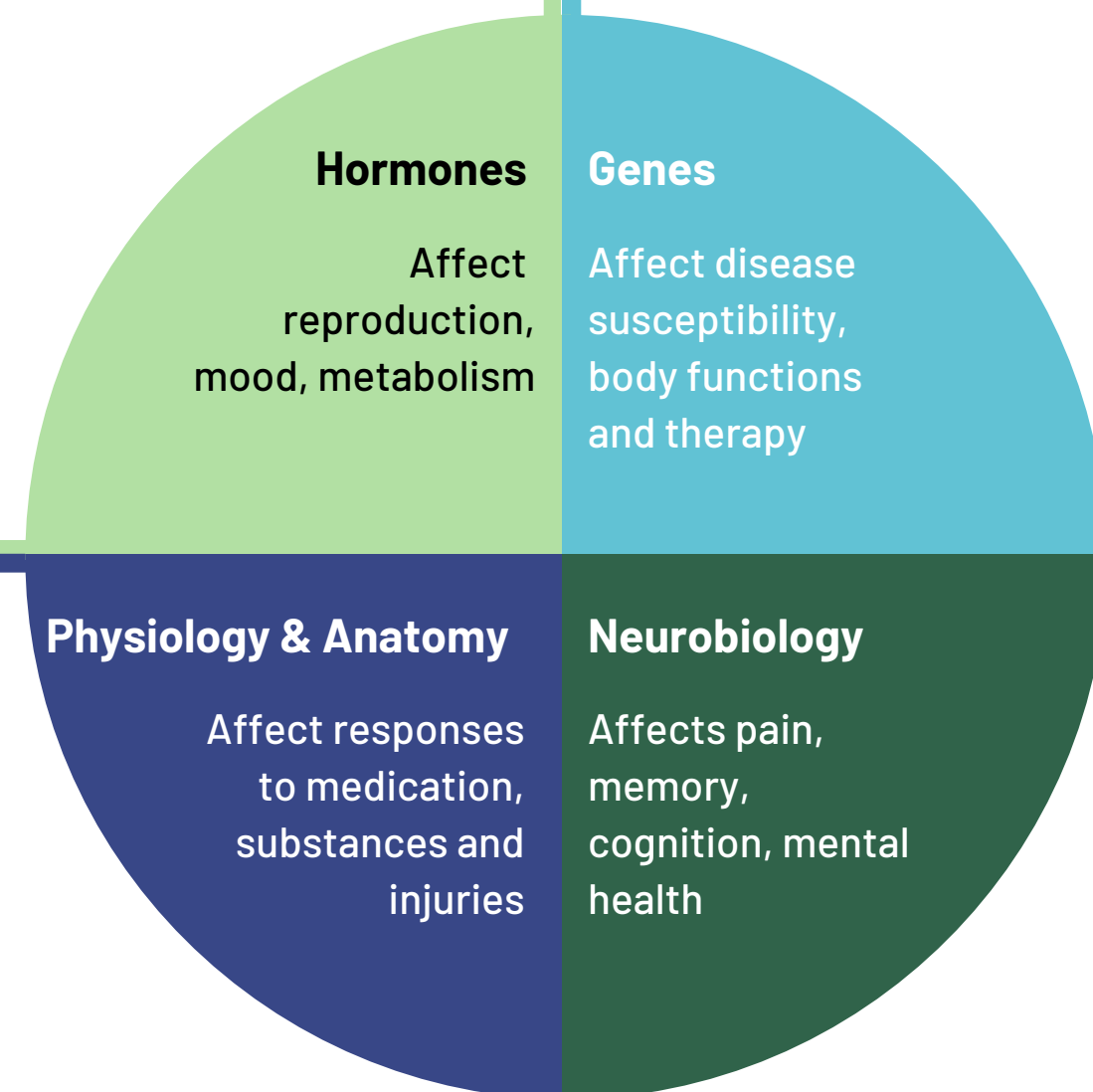

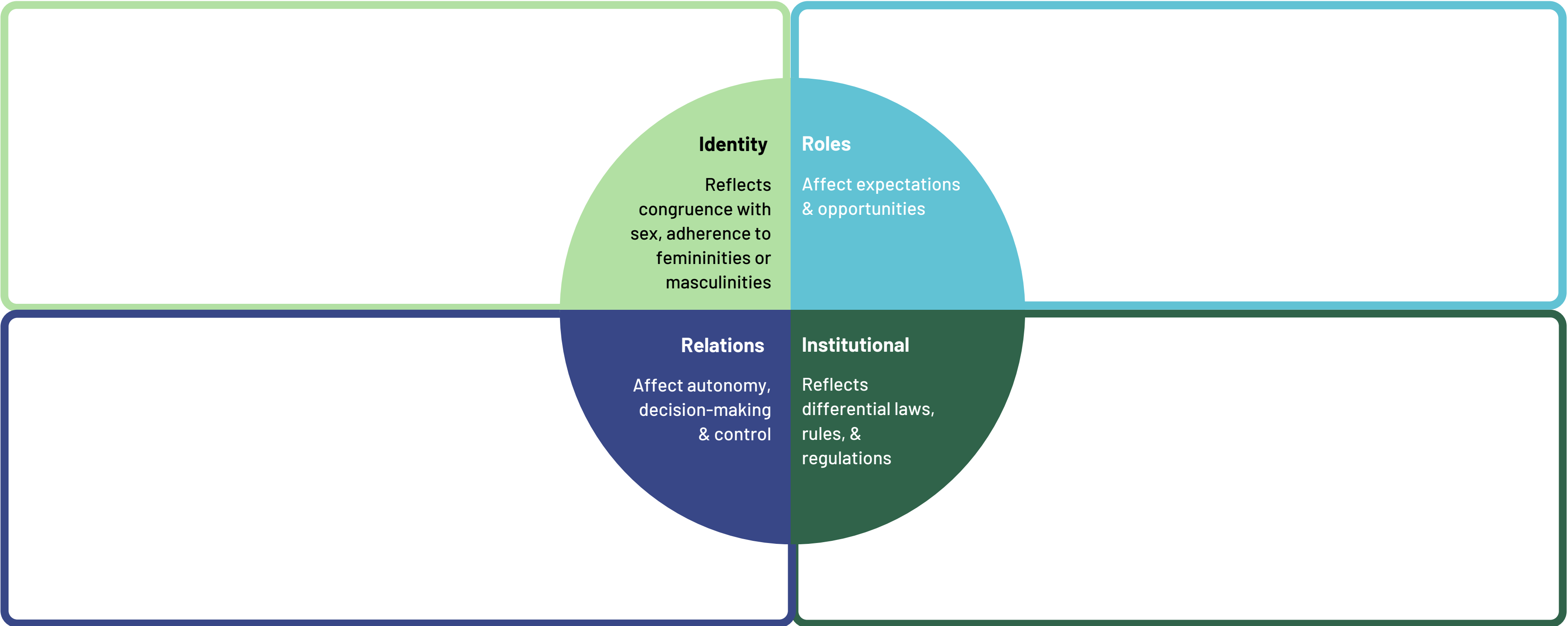
Sex-Related Factors & Health Template
